TOOLS:

general tool box superglue paints in your colour choice flocking powder in your colour choice set of double ended permanent markers—Kmart have a large set at a good price





3D decorative-accent Mirrors—\$5.00 each

Make a whimsical, unique mirror for a variety of settings with Karen B. Choose from various shaped laser-cut wooden frames and various 3D decorative-accents—assorted shells & different sized resin skulls. Paper roses are either white/off-white or purple.

Learn how I "aged" the mirror paper using black chalk based acrylic paint—this will be available for use on the day if you choose to do the creepy skull mirror.

TOOLS:

general toolbox thick tacky glue normal tacky glue

cotton buds wet wipes tweezers

toothpicks strong paper scissors (for cutting mirror paper)

small sandpaper block / emery board (see below—bag of tools)

soft (bristle) paint brushes (different sizes—flat & round)

acrylic paint in your colour choice (I used chalk paints and will have these on the day for you to use)

A bag of useful, assorted tools is available for **\$2.50**—small sanding block; emery board; cotton buds; orange stick; small detail brush; flocked detail stick; alcohol swab; dry blotting squares & long cottonwool tipped toothpick
