

TOOLS:

general tool box cutting mat

craft knife/scalpel pencil

ruler PVA or tacky glue

super glue paint brush

sanding stick—1/8th inch wide (a small number will be available to buy) or, a small needle file

TOOLS:

general tool box jig or Lego/Duplo blocks to square up the unit

ModPodge to seal the laser cut edges

tacky glue sandpaper

acrylic paint of your choice for unit and contrasting colour for handles

TOOLS:

general tool box jig or Lego/Duplo blocks

ModPodge to seal the laser cut edges

tacky glue sandpaper good fabric scissors

acrylic paint of your choice
