Chinese Ginger Jar and Plant Pots—\$10.00

Here is a quilling challenge for the brave amongst you!! You will be making a Chinese ginger jar and some garden pots with *Madeleine*, whilst learning a whole new language while you are at it!?!? 😊

The quilling tool is included in the kit.

TOOLS:

general tool box and craft mat

Glues: PVA glue; wood glue; or Elmer's glue **ONLY!!**
(NO tacky glue!!)

Medium paintbrush and paint palette

non-stick surface to dry items on

Rough and fine sandpaper paint for the garden pots

(no need for paint for the ginger jar as you will be painting this at home)



Vintage Scissor Caddy—\$12.00



From a laser cut kit make a vintage sewing bird or scissor caddy with *Andrea*.

Complete the bird by inserting a pair of scissors as its beak, and fill the little drawer with some cotton reels.

TOOLS:

general tool box

jig or Lego blocks

sandpaper

acrylic paint colour of your choice

chrome marker if you have one

TOOLS:

general tool box

thick tacky glue

red acrylic paint

TOOLS:

awl

tweezers

small sanding block / sandpaper / emery board—whichever you prefer
